Per the latest communication from Cardinal Collins:

- The Province of Ontario is moving out of the “state of emergency” and reverting back to regional restrictions using the colour-coded framework, similar to what was done before the province-wide lockdown.
- The situation remains serious with new variants of Covid-19 present in Ontario.
- The regions of Toronto, Peel & York will not be returning to the provincial framework until Feb. 22, 2021.
- The current limit of 10 persons (including the priest and ushers) present inside a place of worship at any time remains in these regions.
- St. Monica’s Church will remain open for private prayer, confession, Communion Service and Ash distribution as posted on the parish website, the church doors, and the office phone message.
- While Masses remain cancelled, priests will continue to celebrate private Mass daily for the intentions of parishioners and for those suffering from Covid-19. You are encouraged to watch the daily Mass through the Archdiocese of Toronto website ([www.archtoronto.org](http://www.archtoronto.org)).
- Weddings, funerals and baptisms continue to be restricted to 10 persons, including the priest. First Holy Communions and Confirmations continue to be postponed at this time.
